

UAE Foreign Direct Investment Law No. 19/2018

On 23rd September 2018, Federal Decree Law No. 19 of 2018 was passed by His Highness Sheikh Khalifa Bin Zayed Al Nahyan which was later published on 30th September 2018 and came into force on 1st October 2018.

The FDI Law provides a framework permitting foreign 100% ownership in UAE Limited Liability Companies.

BACKGROUND

Prior to the promulgation of the FDI Law, foreign ownership in limited liability companies (LLC) established in UAE was restricted to a maximum of 49% of the share capital of the LLC. This was not conducive for attracting the FDI flows in the UAE. To augment investor confidence thereby increasing the FDI flows to UAE, a relook at permitting upto 100% ownership in the UAE economy was getting imperative. The anticipated legislation was brought out in September 2018 which provides framework for upto 100% foreign ownership. The law provides for Positive List and Negative List of sectors wherein FDI's will be permitted or not permitted. Further, The Foreign Direct Investment Committee (FDI Committee) and The Foreign Direct Investment Unit (FDI Unit) were also established. The FDI Committee was given responsibilities for proposing the FDI policies in the UAE while the FDI Unit was set up as an administrative arm of the FDI Committee.

The Positive List

The Decree Law 19 / 2018 requires the FDI Committee to consider following criteria in respect of the activities and economic sectors whilst compiling the Positive List.

- ▶ Integration with the strategic plans of the UAE
- Value addition to the UAE economy
- Competence, experience and reputation of the relevant foreign investor
- Impact on other national companies engaged in similar activity and
- Whether the activity achieves a positive impact on the environment in the UAE

Subsequently on 2^{nd} July 2019, the UAE Cabinet issued a Resolution ("Positive List") specifying 122 economic activities across 13 sectors which will be eligible for upto 100% ownership.

This sector includes:

- Administrative services
- > Agriculture
- Art and entertainment
- Construction
- Educational services
- Healthcare services
- Hospitality and food services
- Information and communication
- Manufacturing industry
- Professional, scientific and technical activities
- Renewable energy
- > Space
- Transport and storage

With the opening of the above sectors for upto 100% foreign investment, growth in economic activities in the UAE in these sectors is anticipated.

On 17th March 2020, the UAE Cabinet has released the full "Positive List of Economic Sectors and activities" under the Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) Law. The Cabinet Resolution No. 16 of 2020 determines the 'Positive List' of sectors and economic activities in which foreign direct investment is permitted and with 100% ownership.

Cabinet Resolution No. 16 of 2020 also sets condition that companies need to invest in new technologies, contribute to research and development and meet the requirements of UAE licensing entities.

The positive list of economic sectors and activities attached hereto and in which the foreign investor is permitted to invest and approved. The minimum share capital of the Foreign Direct Investment Project in the economic activities stated in the list attached hereto.



The Negative List

Areas of economic activity where foreign ownership in whole or in part is prohibited (a simple reflection of the current existing arrangements) appear on the Negative List. Following activities are included in the Negative List:

- ➢ Oil exploration and production
- Investigation, security, military (including manufacturing of military weapons, explosives, dress and equipments)
- Banking and financing activities
- ➢ Insurance
- Pilgrimage and umrah services
- Certain recruitment activities
- ➢ Water and electricity provision
- Fishing and related services
- Post, telecommunication and other audiovisual services
- ➢ Road and air transport
- Printing and publishing
- Commercial agency
- Medical retail (including pharmacies)
- Blood banks, quarantines and venom / poison banks

Impact and Current structures:

It is left to the discretion of each Emirate of the UAE to decide on the percentage of foreign ownership for each sector / activity as per their individual circumstances. This should be positive as each Emirate is given the discretion to develop the sectors the individual Emirate would like to grow.

Under the Commercial Companies Law a maximum of 49% foreign ownership was permitted. The foreign shareholders can now relook at opportunities to acquire upto 100% ownership in the company.

The Free Zones across UAE permit 100% foreign ownership. The shareholders may relook to move the existing business from Free Zone to the Mainland if it makes valuable economic proposition.
